## MATCH THE FLOWERS TO THEIR FLOWERPOT!

### THINK ABOUT . . .

Understanding number relations is a skill that your child will use in their everyday lives. Connecting the written number to the number of objects helps to build this important skill. Use the Listening and Spoken Language strategy of auditory bombardment when working on the Flower Pot Match worksheet to give your child lots of input.



### MATERIALS NEEDED:

- Flower Pot Match PDF
- Pencil

- 1- Print out Flower Pot Match PDF

### ACTIVITY



- 1- Print out the Flower Pot Match PDF.
- 2- Your child will count the number of flowers that they see on the left side of the page and draw a line to connect it to the corresponding written number in the flowerpot.
- 3- Once they have finished connecting the flowers, they will draw the right number of flowers that match the written number in the flowerpot.
- 4- Use auditory bombardment when working on this worksheet by using your target word as much as you can. "There are *five* flowers. You connected the *five* flowers to the written number *five*"!

### HELPFUL TIPS:

- When using auditory bombardment, pick a target word that your child is unfamiliar with or does not use often. Hearing the target vocabulary word over and over will bombardment your child with the correct way to use and say the word. The goal is for your child to use the word on their own.
