

LANGUAGE ACTIVITY

"LITTLE BAT" HALLOWEEN GAME

THINK ABOUT . . .

This game helps your child practice **asking questions** and **answering yes/no questions** in a fun, playful way. It's also a great way to work on **the preposition "under"** and **labeling colors**. Your child will build language skills while having fun guessing where the bat is hiding!



MATERIALS NEEDED:

- Scissors

PREPARATION:

- 1- Print and cut out the hats and bat on the pages below

VOCABULARY:

- Colors
- Under
- Yes and No
- Hat
- Bat

ACTIVITY

1. **Lay out the hats** in a row so your child can see all the colors.
2. **Hide the bat** under one of the hats while your child looks away.
3. Ask your child to say the question:
"Little bat, little bat, are you under the [color] hat?"
4. **Lift the hat** to check if the bat is there.
5. Ask them "Is the bat there?" and encourage them to answer with **"yes" or "no."**
6. If the bat is not there, keep guessing!
7. When they find the bat, **celebrate** and switch roles if you want!

HELPFUL TIPS:

- Encourage your child to name the colors.
- Model the sentence if your child needs help.
- Make it silly and fun to keep them engaged!
